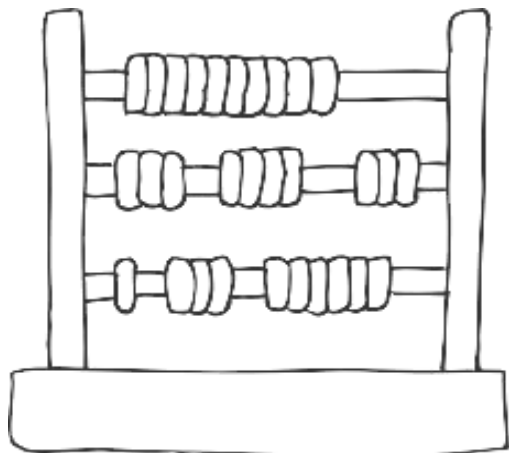

Corrections:
